Learn about the literary associations of Liverpool's public places and secret spaces and look at how home-grown writers have taken Liverpool's distinctive voice to the world, and how eminent visiting authors such as Charles Dickens, Herman Melville and Daniel Defoe have all added to the city's rich literary culture.
